Dress Code for EGCC Golf Course Effective October 1st 2015

Members and their guests are required to respect the Club's dress code requirements and maintain a level of dress commensurate with a private golf club. Proper golf course attire shall be considered the minimum standard of dress, except where noted, while on the golf course and driving range. **Members are responsible for ensuring that their guests are in full compliance with the Clubs dress code requirements.** To assist with the interpretation of the dress code, members and guests are required to observe the following minimum requirements or contact the Club Management or Professional Golf Staff for guidance.

Not Acceptable on the Golf Course or Driving Range

Exercise and fitness clothing, sweat pants, gym shorts.

Tennis shorts, short shorts, cut offs or pool wear.

Pants or shorts with external pleated "patch" pockets (e.g. cargo pants or cargo shorts, shorts that have any oversize pockets on the outside of the shorts).

T-shirts and any casual wear in the style of halter tops, tube tops, racer-back tops and midriff revealing clothing.

Clothing bearing offensive logo's, emblems, slogans, team jerseys, camouflage (unless specific to an event).

Worn out, torn or stained clothing.

Hat and caps, visors, worn backwards.

Hooded sweatshirts (e.g. team type, unless specific to an event).

No denim jeans.

Male members and their guests are to have "polo" golf shirts tucked in at all times.
